World Wide Pentecostal Vigil: Australia was invited to participate in a world-wide Pentecost Vigil which was initiated in Rome commencing at 10pm (Rome time) Sunday May 31st (Eve of Pentecost) East Coast of Australia (6am). This was an opportunity to invite the Holy Spirit to fall afresh and anew on our outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Each State and Community had been asked to source 5 people who would be willing to participate. Requirement would be that they are gifted with a strong gift of singing in tongues. And also able to handle new technology (Zoom I would think?) Australia was asked to contribute 50 voices of the 1000 internationally, to sing strongly in using the Holy Spirit gift of tongues, just like the 'upper room' experience of the first. Our Diocese was represented by Cher Heritage who is a member of Prayer and Praise Group held each 2nd, 3rd and 4th weeks on Wednesday evening at St Therese's Church, Edmonton. Cher stood in the place of accepting the invitation, but her participation was for the whole of our Diocese, Queensland and Australia. Cher said of her experience that "it was something to behold, to be one voice united beyond borders, beyond sickness and unrest, together for the Mercy and power of God to be released over our families, lives and nations was incredibly inspiring and invigorating. We need to lift our eyes above the storm, to the one who calms, restores and fulfills all that has been prophesied to be, Come Holy Spirit, Viva Jesu el senore."
