Did you know?

... that when we bless ourselves with the Sign of the Cross in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, we are performing a gesture that has been part of our faith since its very beginning? This simple hand motion and prayer is our way of confessing our faith, remembering our Baptism, and identifying ourselves as disciples of Christ.

Conversation Starters

- Jesus says we must believe in him. How do we show our belief in our words and actions?
