Did you know?

... that Psalm 145, from which we hear a section this Sunday, was written as an **acrostic poem**? Each line of the psalm begins with a different successive letter of the Hebrew alphabet. The Book of Psalms contains text that was intended to be set to music, and so it is sometimes more poetic in nature than the more narrative parts of the Bible.

Conversation Starters

- What make you tense? What make you peaceful?
- Is your home a source of tension or of peace? Who do you influence it?

Faith in Action

It is easy to worry about things we cannot control. Sometimes this worry can hurt good relationships and make us drift away from our presence with God (never God's presence with us). Think of the things that you have some influence over; that you can change for the good. Write them down, and each evening before going to sleep, speak them to yourself and say: ***God, I leave these with you tonight, so that in the morning we can face them together.***
