Liturgy at Home

Did you know?

... that an excellent way to prepare for Mass is by spending time reflecting on the Scriptures that will be proclaimed that day, especially the Gospel. As we meditate on the Gospel, imagine yourself in the story. Identifying with a particular person and his or her relationship with Jesus might suggest ways in which we might strengthen our friendship with Christ.

Conversation Starters

- What does the Kingdom of God look like for you?
- Why do so many people in the parable not accept the king's invitation? How would you accept the invitation?

This week, recall your invitation to God's banquet by thinking about your Baptism, then your First Communion and Confirmation, and perhaps even your marriage.
