Queensland COVIDSafe Future – Easing of Restrictions for PLACES OF WORSHIP

As at 17 November 2020, *Places of Worship* may gather people at 2square metres (increased from 4square metres). For us, this means we are able to host in excess of 200 people in the church (up from 130 people) and 100 or so people outside if required ... while still complying with social distancing requirements.

Funerals and Weddings may gather 200 people (both indoors or outdoors) at 2square metres).
