20th Sunday in Ordinary Time – Year C
"I have come to bring fire to the earth..." (Luke
12:49) This Sunday's Gospel reminds us of the
challenging and sometimes uncomfortable message of
Christ. Jesus speaks not of peace, but of division—a
startling statement for those who think of Christianity
only as comfort and harmony. Yet, His words call us to
a deeper understanding of discipleship.

The "fire" Jesus speaks of is the fire of transformation, purification, and passionate commitment to truth and justice. Following Him may cause division, even within families, as our values and choices begin to reflect the radical love and truth of the Gospel.
